EducationQuest Foundation is a private nonprofit organization with a mission to improve access to higher education in Nebraska. EducationQuest is headquartered in Lincoln and provides free college planning services at locations in Omaha, Lincoln, Kearney, and Scottsbluff. We also provide services statewide.

EducationQuest employs approximately 35 staff members.

The official name of our organization is **EducationQuest Foundation** (not “the” EducationQuest Foundation)

- EducationQuest is spelled as **one word** (no space between Education and Quest).
- EducationQuest should *never* be abbreviated (i.e. EQF, EdQuest)

EducationQuest fulfills its mission by providing:

- **free** college planning services
- college access resources for middle schools
- grants that help high schools increase their college-going rate
- need-based scholarship programs
- outreach services for community agencies
